General

Classes open to amateur handlers only. Only horses properly nominated through the Silver Sire Futurity Program are eligible for the above classes. Horse eligibility can be verified through Ed Evans at (775) 882-1573.

Show Office

Entry numbers for fully completed entries will be delivered by Silver Sire Show officials on Monday July 12 before 3:00 p.m. to available owners or their designated representatives. All numbers not delivered can be picked up by the owner or handler at the Silver Sire Auction Booth starting Tuesday, July 13 until start of the Silver Sire Show.

Stalls

If your horse is entered in the Region III Championship Show and a stall has already been paid for through the Region III show secretary, no additional stall fee is required for your horse for the Silver Sire Show. You must pay for a stall with your Silver Sire entry if your horse is not already entered in either Region III show and you require a stall. Horses that are not utilizing a stall for either the Region III or Silver Sire shows are still required to pay a \$25.00 trailer-in-fee. All stall fees collected by Silver Sire are paid to Region III.

Class Eligibility

- Auction Yearling Classes: Open only to yearlings that have a Right-to-Show certificate for 2010.
- Open Yearling Classes: Open to yearlings that have a Right-to-Show certificate for 2010 or are the offspring of a mare nominated through the Silver Sire program during the 2008 breeding season.
- 2-Year Old Classes: Open to any horse that has a Right-to Show certificate for the 2009 Silver Sire Show or is the offspring of a mare nominated through the Silver Sire program during the 2007 breeding season.
- 3 & Over Classes: Open to any 3 year or older gelding or mare that is the offspring of a mare nominated through the Silver Sire program during the 2006 or earlier breeding seasons.
- Gambler's Special Class: Open to Half-Arabians of all ages or gender. Class may be split based on number of entries received or by gender at the discretion of Silver Sire Breeder's.

Showing Requirements

All halter classes will be judged in accordance with the USEF rulebook in the following form of presentation:

1. Horses will either walk or trot into the arena. Horses trotting in shall be on a loose line. Immediately upon entry into the arena, the horse will pick up or continue the trot around the arena in a counter-clockwise manner until reaching the ring stewards position or the previous horse exhibited.
2. Once all entries are in the ring the exhibitors will be asked to walk on a loose lead along the rail. After the last horse has passed the judges, the exhibitors will reverse direction and walk with their horses on a loose lead back to their original position in line.
3. The first horse in line will begin presentation on the rail until signaled to approach the

judges. The entry will proceed in a straight line and at a flat-footed walk to ring center for judging. The exhibitor will stop and present their horse upon instruction from the judges at ring center.

4. Only the first horse in line and the second horse "on-deck" will be allowed to prepare the horse for presentation. The only shanking allowed in the remainder of the lineup will be for regaining control of an unruly horse.
5. A horse showing whip marks may be disqualified at the judges discretion. A three minute gate will be used. Horses must be shown in an appropriate show halter with chain. A whip is optional.

Show Attire

Aloha shirts with dark slacks is considered normal attire since this is the general theme of the Silver Sire show. Traditional attire suitable for in-hand presentation may however be used.

Judges and Scoring

A two-judge, points scoring system based on the Arabian Scoring System will be utilized. All individual and class scoring sheets will be made available for viewing on Friday, July 16 after 12:00 pm. at the Silver Sire Stallion Auction booth in the north concourse of the Main Arena.

Show Amenities

A virgin margarita bar and no-host bar will be available during the show. Snacks, chips and salsa will also be provided. Tabled seating for 135-150 people is also provided. The 2010 Silver Sire Auction will be accessible during the Thursday night show with Stallion Service Auction information and on-line bidding access.

Entry Requirements & Submittal

All entries must be legible, complete and submitted with all owed fees. All entries, including any returned and resubmitted entries will be charged with a late fee if submitted after the specified dates. Submitted entries **must include**:

1. Copies of both sides of the horse's registration paper.
2. Copy of the handler's amateur card issued by USEF.
3. A signed copy of the Silver Sire Assumption of Risk waiver for **each** handler.
4. Copies of the Right-to-Show certificate if entered in an Auction Yearling class. Duplicate certificates and Right-to-Show information available through Paul Richied at (775) 741-0601.
5. Written proof of any Right-to Show transfer if not previously submitted to Silver Sire Breeders.

Entries must be postmarked or received by June 1, 2010 to avoid late fees. Entries received from June 2-11, 2010 will be charged with a \$50.00 late fee. There is no stall guarantee for late entries.

Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition (SILVER SIRE FUTURITY HORSE SHOW) to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Silver Sire Breeders, Inc. and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Silver Sire Breeders, Inc. or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Silver Sire Breeders, Inc. or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Silver Sire Breeders, Inc. and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

IF I AM A PARENT OR GUARDIAN of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of the Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that "the Silver Sire Breeders, Inc." and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.
